We currently offer virtual and hybrid meetings for members and the general public. When we can meet in-person or host a watch party for a virtual speaker, we do so in the Franklin Station Room of the Cranberry Public Library, located in the Cranberry Township Municipal Center.

We use Zoom for our virtual programs; it allows members to attend remotely, and affords the opportunity to learn virtually from speakers across the nation.

At our meetings, we host a variety of programs. You might see a formal presentation by an experienced genealogist, training about genealogy software or websites use, learn about cultural heritage, attend a book talk, or participate with speakers about current topics and trends to support genealogical research and family history.
